Jerri: Madison's Dedicated Historian



In the heart of Madison, North Carolina, Jerri made it her life's work to preserve and share the town's rich history. What began as a personal journey into her own family's past—one that dates back to the 1700s—evolved into a lifelong passion for uncovering and telling Madison's story. Jerri's love for history led her to become the town historian, a role she embraced with enthusiasm. She also served as a church historian, ensuring that the stories of faith and community were not lost to time. Her dedication extended beyond research and record-keeping; she actively engaged the public, leading guided bus tours through Madison's historic streets and landmarks. Her commitment to preserving local history was evident in her leadership. For a decade, she served as president of the historic commission, working tirelessly to protect and promote the town's heritage. In 2010, her efforts were recognized when she was honored as Madison's Outstanding Citizen of the Year. Jerri also put her passion into writing, authoring a book about her hometown to ensure its history would be remembered for generations to come. But for her, being a historian was never about accolades—it was about helping people learn and appreciate the past. Through her work, Jerri made history come alive for her community, leaving a lasting impact on Madison, North Carolina.
